

7. To extinguish the burner, let it burn empty or carefully blow it out. With caution run your hand over the top of the stove to make sure it is fully extinguished.

### Warnings and Cautions

- Always exercise caution around the stove and burner. Never touch a hot burner or stove.
- Always ensure flames are fully extinguished before repeating the priming process and/or adding additional fuel. It is often difficult to see the flames during daylight.
- Ensure the burner is both empty and cool before repacking. Never attempt to store or transport fuel in the burner.
- Only use denatured alcohol with the GearPods Burner.

### GearPods® Burner

This burner accessory converts the GearPods Stove to burn denatured alcohol available from most hardware stores. It has two parts: the base and the lid.

### Capacity

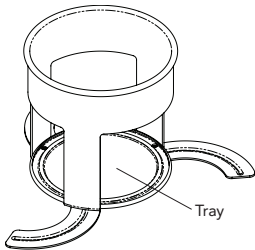
The GearPods Burner holds 0.85 fl oz (25.1 ml) of fuel - sufficient to boil a full GearPods CookMug with a capacity of 9.5 fl oz (281 ml).

### Fuel Storage

GearPods recommends HDPE bottles with a flip top lid such as the GearPods Fuel Bottle (Product Code FU-1).

## How to use the GearPods Burner

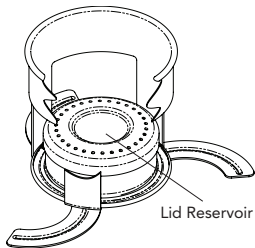
**1.** Pour a little alcohol into the center tray of the stove where the burner will sit. This will help heat the burner later during priming.



**2.** Fill the burner base with fuel and place the lid onto the base, ensuring it is a tight fit.

**3.** Insert the burner through the side of the stove and place it onto the center tray of the stove base.

**4.** Fill the center reservoir on the top of the lid with alcohol.



**5.** Carefully light the lid reservoir and the tray at the base of the burner with matches or other fire starter.

**6.** Once the burner is primed, a flame ring will appear out of the holes in the lid (approx. 1 minute). The stove and burner are now ready to use.

Depending on conditions, it may take more than one attempt to prime the burner. Always ensure that any flames are fully extinguished before adding more fuel to the base and the lid and repeating the priming process.
